

Angular setup document

1. Install node server

Download from <https://nodejs.org/en/>

Click on 8.9.4LTS Recommended for most users.

Double click on the setup file, whichever you downloaded from the above. No need of changing any defaults. Its is automatically updating PATH environment variable.

To check the installation,

Open command prompt and trigger node -version

2. Install Angular CLI.

Open command prompt and trigger the following command.

npm install -g @angular/cli

to check the installation, trigger the following command

ng -version

3. Install Visual Studio Code

Download from <https://code.visualstudio.com/>

Go to downloads and look for windows 7.8.10

Double click on the setup file, whichever you downloaded from the above. No need of changing any defaults.

To check the installation,

Go to all programs → visual studio code → and select visual studio code.

If studio opened, then your installation is very success.

4. Developing Hello world application

1. Open command prompt

Trigger

ng new hello-world

cd hello-world

ng serve

after getting webpack: Compiled successfully.

2. Open browser

Trigger

<http://localhost:4200>

if you are getting “Welcome to App” and seeing angular icon, then your first application is very success.
